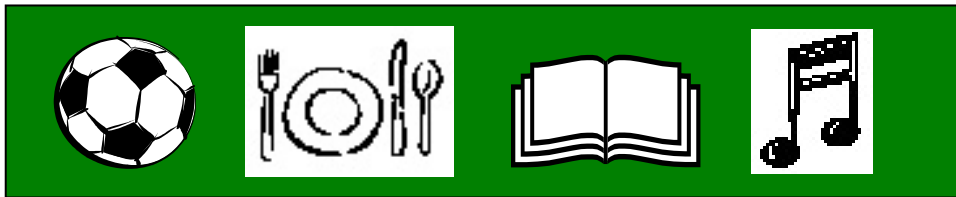


WEDNESDAY CLUB
