



Doodles & Dinner

Did you know the Smithsonian museum has collected the doodles of past presidents? Ever find yourself making random marks on a paper during a meeting or on a phone call?

Would you like to learn some techniques to make your doodles into something more than “just a scribble”? Doodling is easy and can quickly become a beautiful work of art. It can be meditative, a way of planning business ventures and future artworks, a novel, your garden or a new gourmet dish. Learn some techniques for turning you basic doodles into works of art in a visual journal – watercolor, collage, stenciling, stamping, drawing, writing, cutting & more!

Who are these workshops for? Individuals and families with children aged 7 and up (children 6th grade and younger must be accompanied by a parent)

What will I provide?

- Instruction on different surface decoration techniques and the materials to create them.
- Instruction on different doodling and drawing strategies

What do you need to bring?

- A hardcover drawing journal or sketchbook no smaller than 9” x 12” (I recommend plain paper but you might prefer lined – approximately \$16 at Michaels, look for a coupon on-line)
- Several different kinds of pens and any markers, colored pencils or crayons you would like to experiment with using
- Dinner – I will have ice water & coffee & hot chocolate mix

When? Come for 2 1/2 hours of socialization, creative thinking and dinner - 5:30-8pm

Saturday Evening Workshops are \$10 each and I will provide supplies for specific media techniques. Or choose 4 sessions for \$35 (only available if you register in advance). Creative Family Pack (a family of 4) can register for 1 session at \$35. Cash or check only please.
