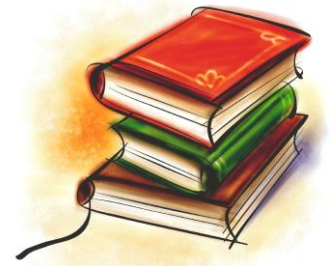


Library Re-Opening!
