

## **TODEE MISSION REPORT JUNE 14, 2010**

- Current student enrollment is 99 students. School has ended, and about 54 students are boarded.
- Mission team formed by Rev. David Milam (St. Andrew PC in Purcellville, VA) will visit Todee August 4–11, 2010. Seven people are going, including representation from Rotary Club of Purcellville. Rotary is working to develop a relationship between Monrovia and Purcellville chapters. (We are still looking for a business manager for Todee, and this could be an avenue for getting one.)
- There will be three major teams to conduct seminars and sessions to help the staff at Todee:
  - \* Educational team: Will help teachers with planning, class curriculum, class structure, class discipline, and admin processes.
  - \* Agriculture team: Will conduct a soil study and give an agriculture seminar to help with building an agriculture program to enable the mission to create a self-sustaining food facility and to be able to sell excess products to area villages.
  - \* Medical team: Will administer health exams, shots, hygiene care, and classes on health care and hygiene. Inova Loudoun Hospital-Lansdowne is supplying two or three pallets of medical supplies to facilitate the team's health care procedures; will send to Liberia prior to the team's arrival. Will be working with JFK Hospital in Monrovia.
- Plan to do Bible study with mission staff and Goba Town Church elders/members. Hope to meet with board members to help with governing process.
- Action plan:
  - \* Review the status of the Todee Mission after the mission trip.
  - \* Have an opportunity to put another container together; will evaluate what is needed. Inova Loudoun Hospital-Lansdowne has additional supplies to send. There are needs for beds, mattresses, etc. The team will further decide necessary items to be shipped. (Will be sending solar flashlights with the team to determine the quantity of lights needed.)
