

## Todee Mission Update

The Todee Study Mission Team is extremely grateful to all who supported us through prayers and generous monetary donations for our trip. Over \$8,000 was collected to help us with travel expenses. Thank you!



The building of a second classroom and teachers' quarters is progressing. The girls' dorm and dining room are almost completed, and the boys' dorm construction is being planned. As more funds are available, work will continue. The medical clinic is functioning under a Nurse Practitioner, and Ophelia Johnson has received the services of four Liberian doctors who are willing to donate one day a month at the clinic. Rice planting has taken place on a couple acres of the school property—please pray for a successful crop.

We are planning to ship a second container to Todee Mission with school furniture, beds, mattresses, sewing machines, books, etc. One great immediate need is FREE warehouse space to store and coordinate this shipment. As soon as our Todee Mission pictures are organized (over 1000 of them), we will be preparing a presentation to show the congregation, which will illustrate the wonderful children at Todee Mission and the gracious people of Goba Town, along with the progression of the rebuilding of the school.

We have been successful in receiving two grants for Todee Mission: \$4,000 from National Capitol Presbytery and \$3,500 from First Calvary Presbyterian Church of Missouri (Betsy Kurtz's church).

Keep Saturday, August 16, 2008, open on your calendars. This is the date of our Todee Mission Fund-raiser being held at Western Presbyterian Church in DC. More details are in this issue of TEMPO and in the church bulletin.
